



Deceleration lane for I-76 West off-ramp starting after Gypsy Lane overpass

Upper Merion Township

Acceleration lane for on-ramp to I-76 West ends before the Weadley Rd. overpass

Demolish existing on-ramp from S. Gulph Rd. to I-76 West and relocate on-ramp to the signalized intersection of S. Henderson and S. Gulph Rds.

New off-ramp for direct access from I-76 West to S. Henderson and S. Gulph Rds.

Relocate on-ramp for direct access to I-76 West from S. Henderson and S. Gulph Rds.

Widen S. Gulph Rd. to two lanes in each direction starting at Crooked Lane

Build proposed sound wall alongside on-ramp

### New I-76 West Ramps at South Henderson and South Gulph Roads

Construction is scheduled to begin in fall 2009 to improve access to and from I-76 West. The project also will improve traffic conditions on local roads and will reduce impacts for those living alongside the relocated on-ramp.

Minor widening of S. Henderson Rd. intersection to improve operating conditions

Widen S. Gulph Rd. to two through lanes and add turn lanes at the intersection

### CONSTRUCTION ELEMENTS

- Construction will begin in fall 2009.
- Two lanes to be maintained on I-76 West. Outside shoulder will be eliminated.
- One travel lane will remain open in each direction on S. Gulph Rd. and S. Henderson Rd.
- Existing on-ramp or relocated on-ramp will be open at all times based on construction staging.
