Free Gun Locks

Gun locks are provide free of charge to township residents to help reduce the risk of accidental discharges of firearms that often result in injuries or fatalities.





POLICE PROGRAMS

Drug Take-Back Box

All drugs, both prescription and over the counter, should not be thrown in the trash or flushed down the toilet when they are no longer needed.

For proper disposal, the UMPD maintains a free drug take-back box, accessible 24 hours a day, in the station's lobby.





POLICE PROGRAMS

Lock for Life Program

This free program provides first responders access to your residence in the event of an emergency through the use of a secure metal lockbox, similar to a realtor's box, near the entrance of your residence when you are unable to open the door.



Road Maintenance

On municipal roads, the Township performs line striping and pavement markings, rebuilding curbs and manholes, pothole and sinkhole repairs, sign installation and signal maintenance, and snow plowing.



The Township is not responsible for state or private roads.

Yard Waste Programs

The curb-side Christmas Tree,
Leaf, and Yard Waste Collection
Programs, street sweeping operations,
and the Compost Site are all components of our
stormwater management program designed to prevent

sediment and debris from entering into our watersheds.

Collections Systems

If a resident has a sewer backup, the Township will dispatch a crew to assess the issue free of charge.

If we are able to clear the backup, the resident can avoid the expense of hiring a plumber.
