

COLLECTION SYSTEM OPERATION & MAINTENANCE WORKER (FT)

Upper Merion Township, located in King of Prussia, PA is looking for a full-time highly motivated *Collection System Operation & Maintenance Worker* who will report directly to the **Assistant Collection System Superintendent**. The work of the *Collection System Operation & Maintenance Worker involves* maintenance work at the semi-skilled level. This employee participates in the checking, cleaning, maintaining, and repairing of pumping stations, sewer lines, and equipment. Work involves heavy physical exertion and exposure to disagreeable conditions and working outdoors through all weather conditions.

The duties of the Collection System Operation & Maintenance Worker include (but not limited to):

- Inspects and monitors pumps, motors, valves, controllers, ventilators, alarms, and equipment contained within the wastewater pump stations and meter pits throughout the Township on a daily basis.
- Collects meter readings and maintains recording equipment at pumping stations and metering sites.
- Monitors condition and operation of pipes and equipment with a video monitor; dislodges and removes manhole covers to access manholes; lowers video camera into manholes with hoisting straps; descends down the ladder into manholes, with proper safety gear.
- Maintains and cleans meter pits; wet wells and dry wells within pumping stations, and buildings and property.
- Advises maintenance mechanics of equipment needing repairs.
- Clears and cleans sanitary sewer lines and storm sewers or removes sewage from wastewater system with a high pressure pumping truck; connects high pressure hoses to pipe valves and operates manual controls on truck to regulate water flow and pressure, or connects vacuum hoses to pipeline system and pump; removes hoses when lines are cleared.
- Sets up signs, barricades and cones to secure work-site.
- Accesses sewage pipeline systems and laterals for repair or installation.
- Operates hand and power tools to break up and remove asphalt or cement surface.
- Drives and operates Township vehicles, trucks, and heavy equipment.
- Clears and maintains Sanitary Sewer Easements.
- Marks PA ONE Call infrastructure locations.
- Performs routine maintenance on Jet Trucks and TV equipment.
- Interacts with residents and contractors.
- Assists with snow and ice removal.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or Equivalent.
- Some experience in equipment maintenance, masonry and carpentry.
- A valid PA Class B Commercial Driver's license.
