



CROSSING GUARD (PT)

Upper Merion Township, located in King of Prussia, PA is looking for a highly motivated, part-time **Crossing Guard**.

This employee is responsible for directing traffic at assigned intersections in order to afford maximum protection to children going to and returning from school.

Salary begins at \$22.60 per hour. Applications are available at www.umtownship.org and at the Upper Merion Township Building Administration Office.

The duties of the part-time crossing guard include (but not limited to):

- Have regular and predictable attendance.
- Stops traffic at designated school crossings to allow children to cross the street safely.
- Ensures children cross safely.
- Assures children are waiting safely away from the roadway.
- Observes children waiting to cross the street.
- Enters the street before any children; and holds up STOP sign to halt traffic.
- When the traffic is stopped and the children are crossing the street, stands holding STOP sign while directing children to cross the street.
- After children are completely across the street and out of danger; walks back to the sidewalk.
- Provides verbal safety guidance to children using the crossing.
- Records and reports license numbers of potentially dangerous vehicles to police department.
- Reports emergencies, equipment defects and traffic dangers.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Minimum age of 18.
- High school diploma or equivalent.
- No felony convictions or conviction of any morals crime.
- Satisfactory Pennsylvania Pa. criminal background check, Pa. child abuse history clearance check and FBI criminal background check.
