The work of the **Collection System Operation & Maintenance Laborer** involves occasional heavy physical exertion and exposure to disagreeable conditions. The successful candidate will participate in the checking, cleaning, maintaining, and repairing of pumping stations, sewer lines, and equipment. Duties include (but are not limited to):

- Inspecting and monitoring pumps, motors, valves, controllers, ventilators, alarms, and equipment contained within the wastewater pump stations and meter pits throughout the Township on a daily basis.
- Monitoring condition and operation of pipes and equipment with a video camera/monitor.
- Clearing and cleaning of sanitary sewer lines and storm sewers.
- Marking PA One Call infrastructure locations.
- Assisting Transportation Division with snow and ice removal.
- Performing other duties as assigned.

The **Collection System Operation & Maintenance Laborer** position will interact with the general public and other Township staff. Successful candidates must have excellent customer service skills, the ability to work well under stressful situations, and demonstrate exceptional problem-solving skills.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or Equivalent.
- Ability and willingness to learn wastewater policy and procedures using manual and technological strategies.
- A valid PA Class B Commercial Driver's license.
