

# POLICE OFFICER EXAMINATION

## UPPER MERION TOWNSHIP

KING OF PRUSSIA, PA

The Upper Merion Township Police Department will be conducting a written examination for the position of probationary police officer on Sunday, September 18, 2022. Applications may be downloaded at <https://www.umtownship.org/departments/public-safety/>, or they may be picked up at the Police Department communications center, 175 W. Valley Forge Rd., King of Prussia, PA 19406. All applications must be returned by 4:00 PM on Wednesday, September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022, with a \$30.00 check or money order payable to Upper Merion Township. Act 120 certification is NOT a requirement to apply.

**TEST LOCATION:** Upper Merion Middle School  
450 Keebler Rd., King of Prussia, Pa

**TIME:** Time will be determined by the number of test sessions required to accommodate all applicants. Check <https://www.umtownship.org/departments/public-safety/> or call 484-636-3890 after September 12, 2022 for your assigned time. Applicants arriving for the incorrect session or late for their assigned session will not be admitted. Applicants will not be contacted directly unless there is an issue with their application.

**TEST INFORMATION:** All applicants must present a photo drivers license and bring two SHARPENED #2 lead pencils. NO Weapons, Phones, Food or Drinks will be allowed in the test site.

**SELECTION PROCESS:** The top 75 written test scores equal to or greater than the median score or 75%, whichever is greater, will be notified to proceed to the physical fitness qualification on Sunday, October 2, 2022. Physical Fitness Standards are available at the Delaware County municipal police academy web site. Graduation standards of the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile age & gender adjusted rankings are used for the physical fitness qualification (<https://www.dccc.edu/academics/other-links/municipal-police-academy/entrance-fitness-test-requirements>). Applicants successfully completing the physical fitness portion will be scheduled for oral interviews.
