

Traffic Signal Technician (FT)

Upper Merion Township, located in King of Prussia, PA, is looking for a highly motivated *Traffic Signal Technician* who will report directly to the *Transportation Superintendent* and be responsible for performing various maintenance and repair tasks on streets, buildings, and equipment. The work of the *Traffic Signal Technician* will involve heavy physical exertion, which will require the proper and safe use of equipment.

The *Traffic Signal Technician* will be responsible for (including, but not limited to):

- Operates hand tools, power tools, hydraulic tools, multimeters, and various electronic test devices.
- Performs scheduled maintenance, installation, and repair of Traffic Signals, Street Lights, Road Signs, various Traffic Control Devices, and Pavement Markings.
- Responds to Traffic Signal emergencies and return them to proper operation.
- Requires incumbent to be on call in a 3-week rotation for after-hours emergencies.
- Trims and removes trees and vegetation to clear sight distance issues.
- Knowledge and use of Microsoft Excel, Word, and Outlook are preferred but not required.
- Use of a computer to input work orders and communicate with various electronic components. Signal Controllers, Network Devices, Surveillance cameras, and various electronic devices.
- Drives and operates an Aerial lift Truck and a dump truck to haul materials or to plow snow and spread salt.
- Assist and work with other departments when requested.
- Work with moving machinery around slippery and/or uneven surfaces, heights up to 60 feet, sharp edges, hot surfaces, dusty conditions, and confined spaces.
- Withstands exposure to weather, high noise levels, vibration, and wet conditions frequently.
- Ability to read prints and manuals related to the signal equipment we maintain.

Minimum Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or equivalent is required.
- Prior experience in driving trucks and aerial lifts is **preferred**.
- A Valid PA Class B Driver's License within 6 months.
