



UPPER MERION TOWNSHIP HAS ADOPTED A "SINGLE-USE PRODUCT REGULATIONS" ORDINANCE

The new ordinance prohibits the use of single-use plastic products in all food and retail establishments within Upper Merion Township.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2024

The prohibition on retail establishments providing single-use carry-out plastic bags begins January 1, 2024.

Retail establishments can provide compliant paper and reusable bags for a fee of at least \$0.10 per bag.
